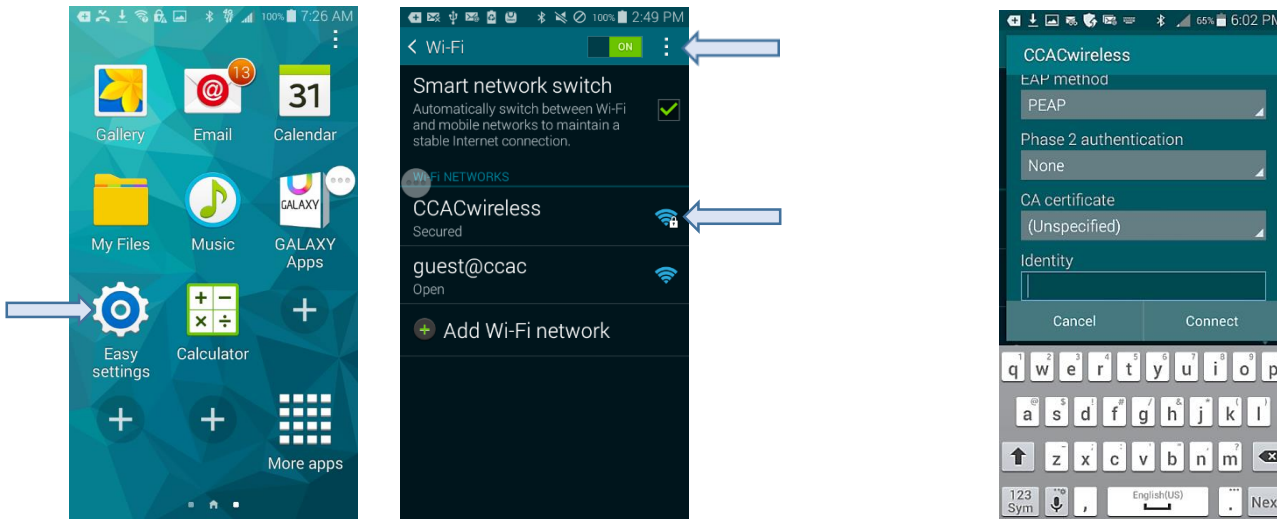


# Connecting Android Devices to the CCACwireless Network

This document will detail the steps on how to connect Android phones and tablets to the secure CCAC campus wireless network. These instructions were created on a device running Android 4.4.2 on a Samsung phone. Your Android device may have a slightly different interface with many of the same options.

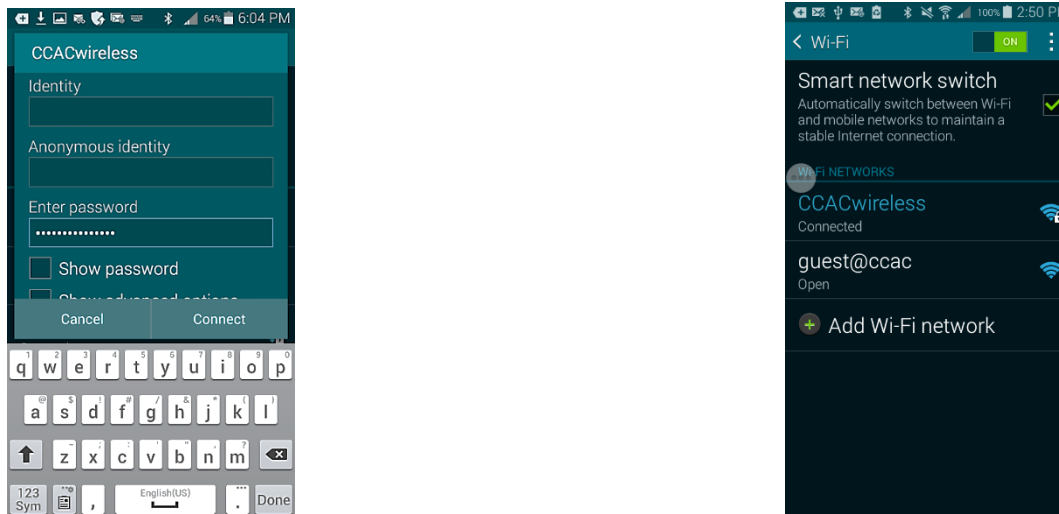
1. Open the Settings application on your device and go to Wi-Fi settings. Make sure Wi-Fi is on. Select the CCACwireless network.

2. Ensure EAP method is set to PEAP. Other settings can be left at “None” or “(unspecified).”



3. Enter your username in the Identity field and your password in the Password field. When finished, tap Connect.

4. When you are finished, you will see the word “Connected” under CCACwireless.



**NOTE:** If you cannot connect to CCACwireless, forget the network and reconnect.
