Micro-Credential Overview

This micro-credential pathway will help participants develop or upgrade industry skills that are necessary or required for Home Health Aides, Nursing Assistants, and Personal Care Aides. Participants will develop, upgrade or update skills for assisting patients or clients with basic, personal activities of daily living. This is the introductory course along the Patient Care Pathway of Micro-Credentials.

Patient Care Pathway

- Activities of Daily Living – 30 hour course
- Certified Nursing Assistant – 5 week course

Upon successful completion of training, participants will be able to:

- Assist a patient or client with personal bathing
- Dress a patient or client with or without the assistance of the patient or client
- Help a patient or client use the toilet
- Transfer patients or clients to or from a bed or chair, to and from sitting and reclining positions
- Care for incontinence in patients or clients
- Feed or assist patients or clients to eat regular meals and snacks
- Do light cleaning and cooking
- Organize medicines for safe consumption by patients and clients

Class begins August 21 – 25, 2017. Classes are held 8:30a.m. – 3:30 p.m. at CCAC Braddock Center, Yost Drive, Braddock.
