A continuing student may graduate with the requirements in effect the year the student entered CCAC. All students must earn 30 college level credits in CCAC classes (this includes distance education courses) and have a minimum institutional GPA of 2.0. Mathematics electives must be at the 100 level. The remaining program credits may include transfer credit, credit by examination, CLEP, or AP examinations. Institutional credits and GPA are used to determine eligibility for graduation.
